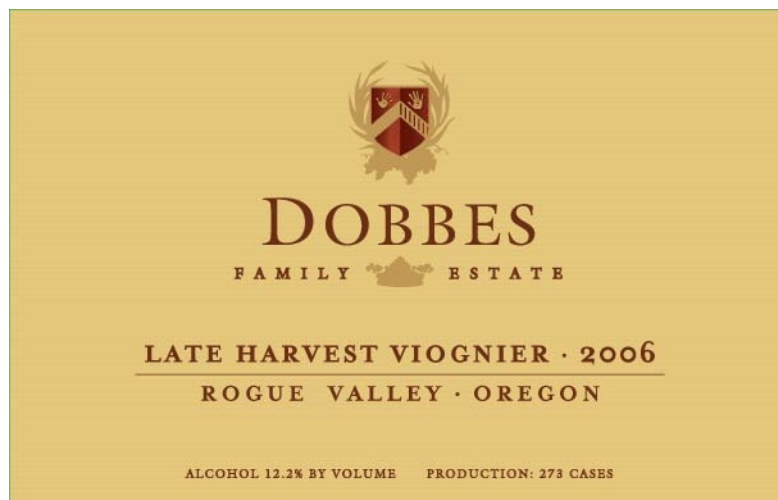

Green-tinged yellow. Fresh peach and honeydew on the nose, with dusty minerals and lime zest lending energy. Silky in texture and not overly sweet, with light-bodied melon and poached pear flavors that gain depth with air. Energetic and brisk for a sweet wine. I'll bet this would make a great aperitif, the way late-harvest Condrieu is often served in the Rhone Valley.
