



2010 Momtazi Vineyard Pinot Noir

This wine wants you to know it is boss from the first smell. The nose presents earth, forest floor, fall leaves, concentrated fruit, and smoky oak. There are assertive acids and strong tannins with flavors of cherry, plum and mushroom. It presents a beautiful tension between earth flavors and fruit. The finish is long an evolving leaving you wanting more. An extremely age-worthy wine.
