



DOBBES FAMILY ESTATE 2012 Fortmiller Vineyard Syrah | Rogue Valley

Sensory Components & Tasting Notes

Color: Ruby-Purple

Aroma: Dark fruit, complex oak, herbal accents

Mouthfeel: Acid entry, medium-full body, structured tannins

Flavor: Ripe dark fruits, dried fig, tobacco, black currant, cherry, black pepper

Finish: Long, with bright acid entry carried by bold, age-able tannins

Complex aroma built on ripe dark fruits, blackberry, Marionberry and red plum; complemented with caramel, cedar, vanilla, tobacco and subtle smoke from toasted oak. A savory thread runs throughout with accents of black pepper. Mouthfeel begins with bright acid and med-full body, followed by flavors of dark cherry, loganberry and blueberry with intriguing, savory, spicy/herbal notes of cedar and black licorice. A long finish opens with mouth-watering acid and is carried by a framework of structured tannins highlighting impressive ageing potential.
