



2013 | Oregon Pinot Noir



Aromas of bright cherry and strawberry along with dark marionberry lead, followed by earthy accents of black licorice and pepper. The palate opens with young tannins, tart and candied cherries and bright acid, transitioning to medium-full body and a finish carried by both juicy acid and structured tannins.

Enjoy lively, young tannins and bright fruit for a more assertive young wine through Spring of 2016 after which the mid palate will broaden and the finish will be softer, carried more by clean acid.
