OUR STORY | Founded in 2002, Wine By Joe / Dobbes Family Estate embodies over three decades of fine winemaking. Today, we are one of Oregon's largest producers. By selecting the finest grapes from Seabreeze Vineyard, our 214-acre estate, and from other premier vineyards, we consistently produce expressions of Oregon's truest varietals. Based in Dundee, Oregon, we are a multi-tiered business with focus on crafting traditional Burgundian style wine under three brands: Dobbes Family Estate, the premier label dedicated to Willamette Valley Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Rosé as well as Rogue Valley Syrah, Viognier and Grenache Blanc.

OUR WINEMAKER | After training under Dobbes for 9 years, Andy McVay has been promoted to Winemaker for the Dobbes Family Estate wines as well as Dundee Vintners, the custom winemaking leg of the business. With a degree in Food and Fermentation Science from Oregon State University and 15 years in the wine industry, McVay has been involved in all aspects of the science of winemaking. "Art, science and agriculture are the three pillars that support my commitment to winemaking. With this foundation, my intent is to craft wines that are complex and diverse, that reflect the personality of their region while maintaining new world innovation," states McVay.

VINEYARDS | Dobbes Family Estate wines are crafted from a wide variety of vineyards in the Willamette and Rogue Valleys, including the Dundee Hills, Chehalem Mountains, Eola-Amity and McMinnville Appellations. Terroir plays an important role in the character development of wine, so all fruit is carefully selected from vineyards with differing elevations, soil types and clones. Single vineyard designates are an expression of each vineyard's unique terroir while distinct cuvées showcase the art of blending while staying true to vintage and varietal character.

WINES | Our fruit is hand-picked and hand-sorted before making our handcrafted wines of distinction. Our job is to bring forth all the flavors, textures, colors and aromas that the fruit has to offer. We make wines that are true to their varietal character, showing as much depth, elegance, opulence and balance as possible.

PORTFOLIO | The Dobbes Family wines includes: Chardonnay, Grenache Blanc, Viognier, Rosé of Pinot Noir, Single Vineyard Pinot Noir, Cuvée Pinot Noir, Syrah, Late Harvest Viognier, and Port-Style Syrah.

2016 GRENACHE BLANC

Grenache Blanc is an exciting white varietal and one of my favorite white wines. The grapes are sourced from Crater View Vineyard in the Rogue Valley grown at 1,400 feet in elevation thriving through long warm days and cool nighttime temperatures - all of which results in the perfect recipe for the development of juicy and well balanced Rogue Valley grapes and wine!

2016 VIOGNIER

This single-vineyard Viognier was whole cluster pressed and is a balancing act of pure fruit from stainless ferment vs. new oak spice increasing the depth of an already complex wine. The warmer temperatures in the Rogue Valley support ripe tropical fruit, complexity and full-body.

2015 GRAND ASSEMBLAGE PINOT NOIR

This wine proves yet again what makes Oregon so special. A blend of vineyards throughout the Willamette Valley join together to show the various, distinctive characteristics from each site and makes a bold statement to the fruit driven nature of the 2015 vintage.

2014 EOLA-AMITY CUVÉE PINOT NOIR

It's hard to express the beauty of the Eola-Amity Hills AVA through words, so instead, we made this wine. The vineyard composition is made of up of 24% Symonette, 35% Eola Springs and 42% Willakia - a region, where rolling hills provide ample opportunity for diverse vineyard sites and excellent blending components.

2015 PATRICIA'S CUVÉE PINOT NOIR

This wine is crafted in honor of Joe's wife. He takes his favorite grapes, off his favorite vines, in his favorite vineyards. We put them in our favorite barrels, and name it after his favorite person. Full-bodied entry on the palate followed by youth-preserving acid and age-worthy tannins.
