2013 GRAND ASSEMBLAGE SYRAH *Rogue Valley*

This Syrah highlights the best of Oregon's Rogue Valley vineyards, whose warm, dry microclimates and high elevations allow for perfectly ripe, gorgeous fruit.

GROWING SEASON

2013 was the driest year since 1985, until the final week of September, Oregon received the remnants of a typhoon that hit Japan. While the last-minute rain presented its challenges, this vintage has delicate layers of complex fruit; a true expression from the Dundee Hills AVA.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Sourced from the Rogue Valley, this Syrah is a pure depiction of what beautiful, sun-kissed Southern Oregon fruit can do. This wine represents an amazing value, as well as offering a high quality red varietal alternative in the heart of Pinot Noir country. The Grand Assemblage is a harmonious blend of Syrah from Fortmiller, Sundown and Quail Run Vineyards and was co-fermented with 1% Viognier from Sundown Vineyard.

Finish: Long, with age-worthy tannins and bright acid
